## UK-France Women in Nuclear Programme

### Privacy Notice for UK applicants

The UK-France Women in Nuclear Partnership is a mentoring programme which brings together early to mid-career women on the British and French Nuclear sectors. The initiative pairs laureates with a senior mentor from the other country and provides events and site visits to help laureates form a network.

The Department for Energy Security and Net Zero is the data controller for UK applicants under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the French Government (French Embassy London and Direction générale de l'énergie et du climat) are data controllers for French applicants under the EU General Data Protection regulation (UK GDPR) for the UK-France Woman in Nuclear Programme

This notice sets out how we will use your personal data, and your rights. It is made under Articles 13 and/or 14 of the UK GDPR.

### YOUR DATA

#### The data

We will process the following personal data: names, contact details, employment history. This is for programme applicants, mentees ("laureates") and mentors.

#### Purpose

The purpose(s) for which we are processing your personal data is: to select new members of the UK-France Women in Nuclear programme, and to contact members throughout the course of their involvement in the programme. Members' names and contact details will be shared with other members to enable them to form a network.

#### Legal basis of processing

The legal basis for processing your personal data is:

**Public task:** Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest. In this case the function is to allow us to recruit new members of the UK-France Women in Nuclear programme, and to contact members.

#### Recipients

Your personal data will be shared between the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero, together with UK representatives from Électricité de France (EDF); Atkins; and Omexom Nuclear Projects. These individuals are part of a steering group representing Women in Nuclear UK.

## UK-France Women in Nuclear Programme

As your personal data will be stored on our IT infrastructure it will also be shared with our data processors Microsoft and Amazon Web Services.

### Retention

Your personal data will be kept for the duration of your participation in the UK-France Women in Nuclear programme. For applicants that are unsuccessful, their data will be destroyed on completion of the recruitment exercise.

### Your Rights

You have the right to request information about how your personal data are processed, and to request a copy of that personal data.

You have the right to request that any inaccuracies in your personal data are rectified without delay.

You have the right to request that any incomplete personal data are completed, including by means of a supplementary statement.

You have the right to request that your personal data are erased if there is no longer a justification for them to be processed.

You have the right in certain circumstances (for example, where accuracy is contested) to request that the processing of your personal data is restricted.

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data where it is processed for direct marketing purposes.

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data.

Your personal data will be processed in the UK only.
